**2013 AMENDMENTS TO THE LONDON PROTOCOL TO REGULATE THE PLACEMENT
OF MATTER FOR OCEAN FERTILIZATION AND OTHER MARINE GEOENGINEERING
ACTIVITIES**

Acceptance by Germany

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the amendments to the 1996 Protocol to the Convention on the Prevention of Marine Pollution by Dumping of Wastes and Other Matter, 1972 (LC PROT 1996), adopted by the eighth Meeting of Contracting Parties to the Protocol on 18 October 2013, by resolution LP.4(8), and to state that he received, on 5 March 2020, an instrument of acceptance of the amendments by the Federal Republic of Germany.

In accordance with article 21(3) of the Protocol, an amendment shall enter into force for the Contracting Parties which have accepted it on the sixtieth day after two thirds of the Contracting Parties have deposited an instrument of acceptance of the amendment with the Organization. Thereafter, the amendment shall enter into force for any other Contracting Party on the sixtieth day after the date on which that Contracting Party has deposited its instrument of acceptance of the amendments. There are, at present, 53 Contracting States to the Protocol.

Acceptance of these amendments by Germany is the sixth acceptance received to date.
