 UK – The MAIB has recently released an accident report on the collision between RoRo passenger ferry 'Red Falcon' and motor cruiser 'Pheonix' in the Thorn Channel, Southampton. It was found that the collision occurred due to unsatisfactory bridge and navigational watchkeeping practices.
